Clipping Points – Yard Operation

SOP-006

1: Introduction

Point clips are used to secure points in the normal or reverse position.

Facing points on running lines must be locked if:

- you cannot be sure that the points will remain in the correct position, or
- there is an instruction at the points to clip and lock them.

A lock may also be used on the clip to ensure the point clip is not removed, authority to use a lock or not is with the Track Manager.

2: Using Point Clips

Use standard point clips for standard points. Standard points have a switch blade and stock rail of similar depth. The standard point clip has a simple hook for the switch blade flange.
