

"Along with the running of the train, there are also plans to upgrade and open Oberon Station as a vibrant Heritage and Railway Display and I look forward to seeing it through to fruition."

Today's announcement follows several other funding deliverables by Andrew Gee including:

- \$22 million for the Murray Darling Medical School

- \$16 million for the crossing at Dixons Long Point
- \$1.9 million to upgrade Blayney's Centrepoint Sports and Leisure Centre
- \$1.06 million for a headspace at Lithgow
- \$1.5 million for an intergenerational child care facility at Wellington's Maranatha House
- Decentralisation of two government departments to the Central West including the Regional Investment Corporation and the Regional Programs Branch
