Explanatory Notes

Worker categories and numbers

Include estimated average worker numbers during the reporting period for each worker category. Include contractors and volunteers under the operator's direct control or supervision.

Definition of worker categories are as follows;-

- Train Drivers include train drivers and second persons only
- Train Guards include train guards and other on-board crew only (eg passenger service attendants). Security and transit officers should be included in the "other" category
- Train Controllers & Signalers include controllers and signalers only
- Station Staff includes station managers and station attendants
- Rolling Stock Maintenance includes engineers, tradespersons and trades assistants undertaking the manufacture, repair and maintenance of rolling stock
- Track & Infrastructure Maintenance includes engineers, tradespersons, trades assistants and any other "around the track personnel" undertaking installation, maintenance and repair of tracks and other infrastructure
- Shunters include workers involved in shunting activities
- Others includes any workers not included in above categories, such as cleaners, support staff, administration staff.

Test numbers and test results

Include numbers of tests conducted for each worker category during the quarter, subject to the following rules;-

- If breakdown of test numbers by worker categories has not been collected, please include totals only and make arrangements to collect all required data in future.
- Total alcohol tests count breath tests, breath analysis and/or blood tests on the same worker on the same day as a single test. Do not count sobriety assessments or other impairment tests.
- Total drug tests count only drug urine and blood tests. Do not count sobriety assessments or other impairment tests.
- Total Positive Drug Tests drug categories are defined as per AS4308. Do not count positive tests which on the basis of expert medical advice are attributable to normal doses of prescription drugs or over-the-counter medications.
- Total Positive and Total Refused tests ensure that individual notification forms are completed and lodged for all cases lodged for all positive and refused tests.
- "Other" Alcohol and Drug tests count tests conducted as part of rehabilitation and return to work programs of workers who have failed earlier testing or self-identified as having a D&A problem. Do not include D&A testing during pre-employment testing, which is not required under the D&A Program Guidelines and is outside the scope of the Regulations.
