#### **Purpose**

To prescribe the rules for use of communications equipment in the *Oberon Tarana Heritage Railway (OTHR) Network.* 

### **Communications equipment**

Communications equipment listed in the following table, or compatible with equipment listed in the table, *may* be used to establish spoken *effective communication* in the Network.

Before *rail traffic travels* in the OTHR Network, equipment fitted to communicate with *the Train Controller* must be working correctly.

If communications equipment is defective, Network Operations Manager must:

- tell Maintenance Representatives about the faulty equipment, and
- establish alternative communication methods.

If *train* communication equipment becomes defective, Drivers must act in accordance with Rule *OTTR 410 Defective equipment*.

The following table lists the protocols to be used for each type of communication equipment.

Communications equipment	Protocol
In Cab radio	Open channel
UHF radios	Open channel
Mobile phones	Discrete-channel
Satellite phones	Discrete-channel
Standard phones	Discrete-channel
