# **Shunting at Intermediate Sidings**

#### **Purpose**

To prescribe the rules for safe *shunting* of *trains* at *intermediate sidings* in the Oberon Tarana Heritage Railway (OTHR) Network.

# Arriving and departing

*Train Crews must* report arrival at and departure from intermediate sidings to the *Train Controller* responsible for the *location*.

#### **Restoring equipment**

After completion of shunting, Train Crews must:

- set points and signals to their normal positions, and
- restore *releases* to their normal positions, and
- return keys to their normal locations.

# Ground frame release

#### Staff Section

The groundframe must be released with the correct key.

# Stabling

The *handbrakes* of unattended detached vehicles must be secured.

#### Stabling trains or vehicles in sidings

If it is necessary to *stable rail traffic* in an intermediate siding, the Train Crew or *track vehicle crew* must tell the Train Controller.

Vehicles, including the *locomotive* if necessary, must be stabled:

- clear of the running line, and
- inside *derail devices*.
