Purpose

To prescribe the responsibilities of *Train Controllers* in the Oberon Tarana Heritage Railway (OTHR) Network.

Responsibilities

The primary responsibility of the Train Controller is to manage *train* paths for the safe and efficient *transit of rail traffic* through the OTHR Network.

Train Controller *must* plan, set priorities for and manage:

- train services
- *work on track authorities*
- *Proceed Authorities*
- liaison with relevant *Operators* and *Maintenance Representatives* and external services during incident management
- available facilities to restore train services safely and promptly.

Train Controllers must:

- respond to equipment failures and warning alarms
- promptly report breaches of OTHR *Network Rules* and *Network Procedures* to the Network Operations Manager and affected *Operator's Representatives*.

Train Controllers must compile and maintain, in *permanent form*, relevant records and reports about conditions and movements in the OTHR Network.
